

Issuance of Multiple Temporary Visitor Visas for Nationals of India

The Government of Japan has decided to begin issuance from July 3 of multiple temporary visitor visas to nationals of India (ordinary passport holders)

Starting day: 3 July, 2014

Recipient: Those who have fulfilled certain conditions and hold a general IC (with microchip) passports or an ordinary Machine-Readable passport (MRP) meeting International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) standards.

Period of stay: 15 days or less.

Necessary documents for application:

- ① Application form
 - ② Passport (original and copy)
 - ③ Hong Kong or Macau identity card (original and copy)
 - ④ Valid Hong Kong or Macau residency visa (original and copy)
 - ⑤ One passport-size color photo taken within 6 months (45mm X 45mm, front-facing, without hat, without background)
 - ⑥ Documents showing ability to support the travel expenses
Applicant or supporter's (spouse or offspring) past year's salary proof from an official organization; or past 3 months' bank book or bank statements in the name of the applicant (original and copy).
 - ⑦ Certificate of employment.
 - ⑧ Reason for requesting a MULTIPLE entry visa.
 - ⑨ For dependents, the spouse's or parent's certificate of employment together with proof of the legal relationship, such as marriage and/or birth certificates (original and copy)
- ※ Please note that applicants may be requested to provide any other document deemed necessary.
