

Hong Kong-Japan Business Co-operation Committee will be awarded
the Japanese Foreign Minister's Commendations for FY 2014

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan announced that the Japanese Foreign Minister's Commendation 2014 will be awarded to Hong Kong-Japan Business Co-operation Committee.

Hong Kong-Japan Business Co-operation Committee was established in 1979 with the purpose of promoting trade/investment between Hong Kong and Japan through enhanced business communication between Hong Kong and Japan at a hi-level. The Committee and Japan Business Federation arrange reciprocal visit every year and hold joint committee to discuss various topics including information sharing and economic cooperation, and have contributed to the promotion of economic relations between Japan and Hong Kong for the past 35 years. To remark its distinguished contributions, this year's Commendations was announced to be awarded to Hong Kong-Japan Business Co-operation Committee.

The Foreign Minister's Commendations are awarded to individuals and groups with outstanding achievements in international fields, to acknowledge their contributions to the promotion of friendship between Japan and other countries and areas. This year, the Commendation will be awarded to 108 individuals and 30 groups, and Hong Kong-Japan Business Co-operation Committee has been selected as one of the groups to receive the Commendations.

The Foreign Minister's Commendations award presentation ceremony to the Committee will be held at a later date here in Hong Kong.
