Issuance of Multiple Temporary Visitor Visas for

Nationals of Indonesia, Philippines, and Vietnam

The Government of Japan has decided to begin issuance from September 30 of multiple temporary visitor visas to nationals of Indonesia, Philippines and Vietnam (ordinary passport holders)

Starting day: 30 September, 2014

Recipient: Those who have fulfilled certain conditions and hold a general IC (with microchip) passports or an ordinary Machine-Readable passport (MRP) meeting International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) standards.

Period of stay: 15 days or 30 days.

Necessary documents for application:

- Application form
- ② Passport (original and copy)
- 3 Hong Kong or Macau identity card (original and copy)
- 4 Valid Hong Kong or Macau residency visa (original and copy)
- ⑤ One passport-size color photo taken within 6 months (45mm X 45mm, front-facing, without hat, without background)
- ⑥ Documents showing ability to support the travel expenses Applicant or supporter's (spouse or offspring) past year's salary proof from an official organization; or past 3 months' bank book or bank statements in the name of the applicant (original and copy).
- 7 Certificate of employment.
- Reason for requesting a MULTIPLE entry visa.
- For dependents, the spouse's or parent's certificate of employment together with proof of the legal relationship, such as marriage and/or birth certificates (original and copy)
- Please note that applicants may be requested to provide any other document deemed necessary.
